**THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS HEREBY PROMULGATED**

**IN RE: ORDER NO. 2020-45**

**DOCKET NO. 10-20-20-09**

This cause came for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board of Alabama (hereinafter referred to as “Board”) on the petition of URBAN OIL & GAS GROUP, LLC, (hereinafter referred to as “Urban Oil and Gas”) a foreign limited liability company, authorized to do and doing business in the State of Alabama, requesting the State Oil and Gas Board to enter an order approving shut-in status, and extending shut-in status, for certain wells located in the White Oak Creek Coal Degasification Field, Tuscaloosa and Walker Counties, Alabama.

The Board, after receiving and considering the evidence, finds that due and proper notice of hearing of said cause has been given in the manner and form and for the time required by law and the rules and regulations of the Board, and that proofs of publication of notice are on file with the Board, and that the Board has full jurisdiction of this matter. The Board, being fully informed and advised in the premises, finds as follows:

**I.**

That in 2019, Urban Oil & Gas acquired from ARP Production Company, LLC, all of its interest in certain wells located in the White Oak Creek Coal Degasification Field located in Tuscaloosa and Walker Counties, Alabama. On February 26, 2019, the Board approved the Application for Change of Operator filed by Urban Oil & Gas for the ARP Production Company, LLC operated wells in the said White Oak Creek Coal Degasification Field, and Urban Oil & Gas became the operator of said wells.

**II.**

The wells now being requested for shut-in status, or an extension of shut-in status, for the White Oak Coal Degasification Field are listed in Exhibit “A” attached hereto.

**III.**

That Petitioner is in the process of evaluating the wells listed in Exhibit A to determine their future utility in its operational program. As part of that process, Petitioner is herein requesting

that said wells be approved for shut-in status, or an extension of shut-in status, for one year in order to allow additional time for the individual well evaluations.

**IV.**

That said wells have future utility and are capable of producing and should not be plugged and that the wells are monitored and are in a safe condition.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

**V.**

The evidence indicates that the wells in the White Oak Creek Coal Degasification Field listed in Exhibit "A" attached hereto have been productive in the past and that shut-in status is due to be granted for these wells.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

The granting of this request will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

Based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth hereinabove, IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the State Oil and Gas Board of Alabama that the Petition bearing Docket No. 10-20-20-09 be and is hereby GRANTED, establishing shut-in status and extending shut-in status for those certain wells located in the White Oak Creek Coal Degasification Field listed in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of this Order or until the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board




