NOTICE OF MEETING

The State Oil and Gas Board of Alabama will hold its regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, February 27, 2001 and Friday, March 2, 2001 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board Room of the State Oil and Gas Board Building on The University of Alabama Campus, Tuscaloosa, Alabama, to consider, among other items of business, the following petition:

DOCKET NO. 2-27-01-3

Petition by PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY, a Delaware corporation, authorized to do and doing business in the State of Alabama, as Successor in Interest by merger with RIVER GAS CORPORATION, requesting the State Oil and Gas Board to enter an order force pooling, with a risk compensation penalty, all tracts and interests in hydrocarbons produced from the Pottsville Formation in the Chevron 08-05-181 Well, to be drilled on a 40-acre unit consisting of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 8, Township 17 South, Range 8 West, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, in the White Oak Creek Coal Degasification Field. This Petition is in accordance with Section 9-17-13, *Code of Alabama* (1975), as amended, and Rule 400-7-2-.01 of the *State Oil and Gas Board of Alabama Administrative Code*.

The above-described 40-acre unit was previously force pooled, without imposition of a risk compensation penalty, by the Board in Order No. 2000-161 issued on August 25, 2000. However, the permit for this well will expire on February 25, 2001.

The public is further advised that, pursuant to this hearing, the applicable provisions of the Code of Alabama (1975), and the State Oil and Gas Board of Alabama Administrative Code, the Board will enter such Order or Orders as in its judgment may be necessary in accordance with the evidence submitted and accepted.

The public is invited to attend this meeting; however, you may elect to submit your comments in writing regarding a particular item before the Board. **YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO ATTEND NOR ARE YOU REQUIRED TO MAKE ANY WRITTEN COMMENTS. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS CONCERNING THE ITEM NOTICED OR ANY QUESTIONS CONCERNING THE BOARD'S PROCEDURE, CONTACT THE OIL AND GAS SUPERVISOR. PERSONS EXPECTING TO OPPOSE THE ABOVE NOTICED ITEM ARE REQUESTED TO NOTIFY THE BOARD OF THEIR OPPOSITION WITHIN 48 HOURS PRIOR TO THE MEETING DATE.**
