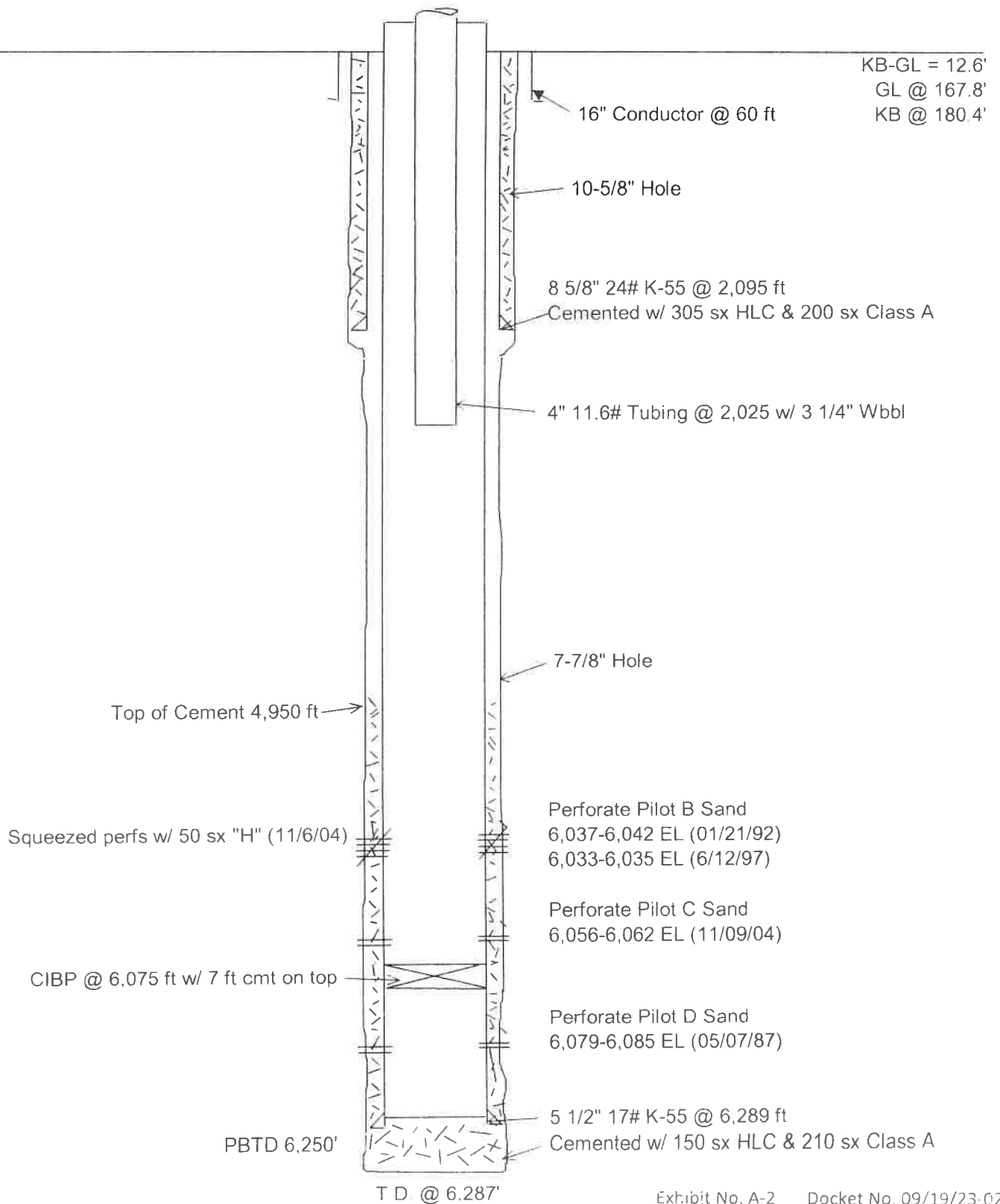

1. That John D. Herlihy is qualified as an expert witness before the State Oil and Gas Board of Alabama,

2. That the petitioner is the operator of the A.T.I.C. 34-16 #2 well, Permit No. 5195, located in Section 34, Township 2 North, Range 8 East, Foshee Field, Escambia County, Alabama.

3. That the above described well is temporarily abandoned due to non-commercial oil production rates. Petitioner requests that the Board extend the temporarily abandoned status of this well for a period of one (1) year in accordance with Rule 100-1-4-.17(1) of the *State Oil and Gas Board of Alabama Administrative Code* because this well may be utilized in petitioner's operations in Alabama for the following reasons and therefore should not be plugged.

4. That the petitioner believes that the A.T.I.C. 34-16 #2 well could be utilized as a salt water disposal well to dispose of salt water produced in Foshee Field, should disposal capacity of the disposal well in Foshee become unavailable.

5. That the petitioner has plugged other wells in Foshee, West Foshee, Osaka and Pollard Fields that had no future utility in a timely manner.

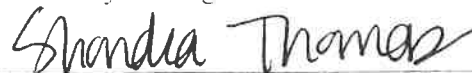

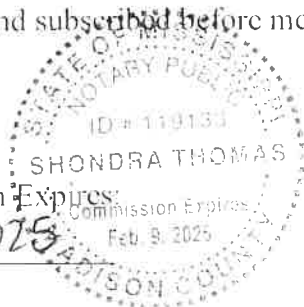
